Nice work Royden!!! You really got the whole story in there!  
This kind of poster seems designed for cases where you explain orally what it is about.  
But visually, just a couple of little comments.

The four triangles don't get a message across to me—but maybe that is in the telling.

The box for modeling is offset in a way that makes the connection to the T-drive awkward. Could you shorten up the T-ratio graph so you could have “modeling” at the end of both the T-drive and CRIPR Drive?

Where you have the arrows pointing to the flags from the bottom it looks like GBIRD is specifically interacting with one country—easy to fix with a box around the title.

I'm sure it would do fine with none of my suggested changes.
